





















The program is being implemented in the Special Protection Area (SPA) of Andros (GR4220028), which is part of the pan-European network of protected areas Natura 2000, a network of over 26.000 sites.

This area is of high nature value, as it hosts, among other, four endangered species of birds, two birds of prey and two seabirds: the Eleonora's Falcon, the Bonelli's Eagle, the Audouin's Gull and the Mediterranean Shag.





Management Plan.

 Creation of artificial nests and establishment of thickets of natural shrubs to help nesting of protected species.

- Fight some of the invasive species human unintentionally have brought in the bird colonies.
- prey for the protected bird species.
- Protect and promote local awareness for the wetlands of Andros.
- Repair and reoperate
- Protect underwater Posidonia meadows installing seagrass-friendly moorings for boats.
- Carry out patrolling and guarding of the protected area.

How this helps Andros:

- Andros is being turned into a top environmental destination of Greece.
- Highlights the organization and development prospect of qualitative ecotourism (which has the possibility of many months duration).
- The protection of wildlife species and their habitats helps the development of ecoturism and highlighting the coastal recreation sites, on which the island communities primarily depend.
