Wardening plan for Andros SPA

Summary

The goal of the Wardening Plan is to organize the available means and plan the best oversight of the region. More specifically, in order to be a practical tool that will help organize stakeholders, it should:

1. Gather available resources in human resources, media equipment, and necessary fuel for the surveillance of the area.

2. Collect data on habitats and the bird species in the wider area of Andros island.

3. Collect data on significant time periods during the year where significant biological processes of species such as reproduction take place.

4. Collect data related to the human activities that take place in the wider area and the ones that are potentially threatening or putting pressure on these species populations as well as when they are more intense during the year.

5. Design optimal patrol routes so as to be as efficient as possible in the coverage of the above habitats

6. Plan patrols throughout the year so that they are achieved using optimally the available resources.

7. Provide alternative methods and be able to adapt based on upcoming changes that are likely to occur and be able to redesign the plan accordingly with new or existing data.
